

What follows is Erik's detailed, moment-by-moment account of his death, transition, and the new life he discovers on the other side—told for the very first time in his own words as channeled by renowned medium Jamie Butler and transcribed by Erik's mother, Elisa Medhus, MD.

The follow-up to *My Son and the Afterlife* (Beyond Words/Atria, 2013), Erik delivers on his promise to show what heaven is like and how it works. Erik's candor, irreverent humor, and fascinating story is riveting, while also offering guidance, hope, and a deeper understanding of what happens when your time on Earth ends.

My Life After Death provides peace and solace for those who have grieved a loss, and answers crucial questions for anyone who has ever wondered about the existence of an afterlife. Ultimately, Erik's message is, "Life never truly ends."

Erik explains that death is a transition, not a separation or end of life, and that consciousness lives on. He offers ways of creating a new relationship with those who have died, so you "don't just bury them," as well as a glimpse into heaven. *Life After Death* explores questions such as:

- What happens to our loved ones right after their physical "death"
- What crossing over is like and the life review
- What does the afterlife feel and look like
- Why communication with the other side is helpful
- "Jobs" in the afterlife and why we have them

"One thing unique about Erik is his style. He's candid, casual and often blunt," Dr. Medhus explains. "This along with his 'sailor talk,' seems to make him more approachable unlike other spirits who begin with, 'Welcome my dear one.' As far as the bad language is concerned, Erik says, 'Words are just a string of letters. They get their power from the intent behind them,' and his intent is pure and loving."
